It is the authentic recreation of the Paulée de Meursault. There are great wines such as Henri Jaye Vosne-Romanée "Brûlée" 1985, Domaine Dujac Clos de la Roche 1969, Comte de Vogue Musigny 1945. Just a taste, then furious writing of notes, then on to the next wine. This is hard work.

It is an intoxicating, gripping, inspirational evening. This feeling is perhaps what inspired the Greeks to accept wine and the god Dionysus and what also terrified them about his power. As with any cult, you have to be an acolyte.

It is not too late to catch La Paulée...this year. It is an ingenious idea, a crazy idea, and an event worth seeking out.
